# For your Spiritual Growth:

This is a follow-up to the letter you recently received in the mail.

#### Instruction of the Apostles ~

Following the Book of Acts we have the letters of St. Paul. They are arranged according to length; so his letter to the Romans. which is the longest, is placed first, and the shortest, his letter to Philemon, which is only 25 verses is placed last. The oldest, or earliest of his Epistles is to the Thessalonians.

# II. Breaking of the Bread ~ (Basic Outline of Mass)

(1 Cor:11:20~21) When you meet in one place, then, it is not to eat the Lord's Supper, for in eating, each one goes ahead with his own supper, and one goes hungry, while another gets drunk.

#### III. Communal Life ~

"They devoted themselves to community life." Throughout the history of our faith, even in its very beginning, God was forming a "people for Himself." "I will be your God, and you will be my people."

#### IV. Prayer ~

"Give us this day our daily bread" It asks for God to give us this day what we need to sustain all ~ our daily bread ~ not for wealth, riches, or power, but as God fed the people in the desert one day at a time. Jesus tells us "not to worry about tomorrow." Today we ask for what we need today.
