Dear Parishioners.

Happy Lent! May this season serve to open our minds & hearts to the love of God, that we will become a more loving veovle—both of God and neighbor.

We can only give what we receive. For any of us to be able to follow the command of Christ-"Love one another as I have loved you," we have to allow His love to penetrate more deeply into our being...to heal the woundedness that sin has caused within us. We are called not to ignore it, or hide from it, but to acknowledge it.

Sin often locks us up inside of ourselves. It closes us off from God and others. The story of Adam & Eve in the garden says the "hid" themselves. God asked "why?" to which Adam responded, "I was afraid because I was naked, so I hid myself." We hide behind masks, walls, anger, or pretense. In so many ways because "we are afraid." How many times it is a fear that blocks us from doing many things that would benefit us. How many times have we failed to befriend others; try something new that we might really enjoy; speak out against a wrong? Some people live lives totally imprisoned behind a wall of fear.

How often the Sacrament of Reconciliation is avoided because someone is afraid. There is no greater way of be released from the power of sin than through confession. People have been burdened by sin for years, afraid to confess it, and all it would take is "Father, forgive me for I have sinned...." It has been a grace for me both to receive the Sacrament, as well as share it with others, freeing them from the person they have been locked with.

Sin distorts our vision. It is God we become afraid of – but a God who loves us. The fear should be of the sin and the power of evil- for this is what truly harms us. The devil delights in our being afraid. Fear is his hold over us. Break that fear this Lent.
