Ordinary Time

“Christmas Time and Easter Time highlight the central mysteries of the Paschal Mystery, namely, the Incarnation, Death on the Cross, Resurrection, and Ascension of Jesus Christ, and the descent of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. The Sundays and weeks of Ordinary Time, on the other hand, take us through the life of Christ. This is the time of conversion. This is living the life of Christ.” (USCCB website)

“The title Ordinary Time does not imply that these weeks lack importance. The name ‘Ordinary’ is used because their names are derived from the ordinal numbers, thus the Third Week in Ordinary Time, the Eleventh Week in Ordinary Time, and so on. In these weeks, ‘no particular aspect of the mystery of Christ is celebrated, but rather the mystery of Christ is honored in its fullness, especially on Sundays’ (*Universal Norms on the Liturgical Year and General Roman Calendar*, no. 43). These weeks allow us to reflect carefully on Jesus’ ministry—his preaching, his parables, and his miracles.

“The Sunday after Pentecost is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. ‘With the growth of devotion to the mystery of God in his Unity and Trinity, John XXII extended the feast of the Holy Trinity to the entire Latin Church in 1334’ (*Directory on Popular Piety in the Liturgy*, no. 157). The Sunday following Trinity Sunday is celebrated as the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ (in much of the Church, this feast is celebrated on the preceding Thursday). . . . In many places, this solemnity is celebrated with public processions of the Blessed Sacrament and extended periods of Eucharistic adoration. These Sundays replace the Sundays in Ordinary Time, though the weeks following are numbered. Similarly, the week after the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord is the First Week in Ordinary Time.” (*Essential Guide to Seasons and Saints*)

“Ordinary Time is a time for growth and maturation, a time in which the mystery of Christ is called to penetrate ever more deeply into history until all things are finally caught up in Christ. The goal, toward which all of history is directed, is represented by the final Sunday in Ordinary Time, the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe.” (USCCB website)
